Speech. Speech Literacy link</p>	<p>Previous Learning: Locational knowledge about climate, continents and oceans in Year 2, 3, 4 and early Year 5. The children have engaged with learning about Immingham dock in Year 4 they have knowledge of imported and exported goods. Preparing for: Links to the Year 6 learning about being pioneers for a better society. Prepares the children for life outside of school by getting them to consider ethical choices. Bespoke to our school: Children engage with learning about trade routes and goods that are imported through Immingham dock.</p>
