Attendance

Regular attendance at school is the most important way that parents can ensure that their child reaches their academic potential and receives the pastoral support they need. For the last few years, since the Covid pandemic it has been quite confusing for parents as to whether they can send their child to school with coughs and cold-like symptoms. The UK Health Security Agency (UKHSA) says that children should attend school with cold like symptoms such as runny noses, sore throats and coughs. Please remember that early morning aches and pains often pass, so don't keep your child at home 'just in case' when they could be learning in class. When you send your child to school with minor aches or pains, please tell the school staff and they will phone you if your child continues to have symptoms. An absence from school due to cold like symptoms may not be authorised. There are very few reasons we can authorise an absence from school. If unsure as to whether your child should attend school then please contact Mrs Drew or the school office who will advise you.
