Fine and Gross motor activities

To help develop your muscles for writing please have a go at some of the following activities.

Gross motor

- Play hopscotch or practise skipping (with/without a rope)
- Go on a bike/scooter ride – how fast can you go?

Fine motor

- Practise holding a pencil correctly between your thumb and two fingers, holding the pencil low near the point -can you draw lines and circles in different directions.
- Look out of your window, what can you see? – Draw it.

Project response

This half term we are learning about Jack and the Beanstalk and will be planting our own beans.

- Read/watch the story of Jack and the beanstalk – what happens?
- Have a look in your garden or on a walk – can you see anything growing? – what is it?
- You will be bringing your plant home – take care of it, water it and watch it grow.



Number facts and accurate counting

- What numbers can you recognise:

0 5 3 2 4 1

- Spot the numbers in the environment – go on a walk, what numbers can you spot? Look on doors, gates and signs.
- Accurate counting – choose a number between 0 and 5 – collect that many objects, line them up and touch count them correctly – how many have you got?
- Repeat with a different number.
