





Year 1 Knowledge organiser: How do the physical features of our environment let us know that Summer is coming?

		seasons	The seasons are four different times during the year with different types of weather. They are spring, summer, autumn and winter.
Which months of the year are in which season? What changes can we see around us in each season?	What type of clothing would you wear in each season? Why?	temperature	Is a degree of hotness or coldness this can be measured using a thermometer.
	Which animals are born in the Spring? Which animals hibernate in the Winter?	thermometer	Used for measuring or showing temperature (how hot or cold something is)
	pond	A pond is smaller than a lake. Wildlife live in ponds such as ducks, swans, fish and frogs.	
	wildlife	Animals living in their natural environment. They don't have an owner they live in the wild and fend for themselves.	
	nature	The natural earth and things on it like trees, forests, birds and animals.	
	farm	A farm is an area of land, together with buildings on it, that is used for growing crops or raising animals.	

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
