Learning with Parents Trial

During the last term, our Years 1, 3 and 6 children have had access to an online reading record. This is an online and easy way to record home reading instead of the blue paper reading records. This has been really successful and it has been lovely to read your comments and watch the videos which have been uploaded. We are going to extend this trial this half term to include maths homework for Years 1, 3 and 6. Starting on Friday 26th April, children will be sent a piece of maths homework to complete. This will be sent to you by email in the same way as the reading record. Children in all other year groups will continue to receive a paper copy of home learning this term.

Statutory Assessment Weeks

This term some of our children will complete statutory assessments. These are assessments which the government state all children in certain year groups must undertake in all schools across the country. These assessments can only be completed on specific dates so it is really important that your child is in school on these dates.

These are as follows:

Year 6 SATs Week: Monday 13th May- Friday 17th May

Year 4 Multiplication Check: Monday 3^{rd} June-Friday 7^{th} June

Year 1 and 2 Phonics Screening Check: Monday 10th June-Friday 14th June
