Dear Parents and Carers,

As we reach the end of term, I would like to take the opportunity to revisit the uniform expectations. Uniform is an important part of a school's identity. It reinforces who we are as a community and helps promote a sense of pride in the school.

I know many of you may be considering purchasing new uniform for the warmer Summer months so to ensure that you do not buy items of uniform which do not fall in line with our uniform policy a reminder is below. Our full policy is available on our school website.

Clothing:

- Grey or black fitted trousers, skirt or pinafore dress (not joggers or leggings)
- White or pale blue polo shirt
- Royal blue cardigan or jumper with or without the school logo
- Royal blue checked dress in the Summer
- Grey or black fitted school shorts (not sports shorts or cycling shorts)

Footwear:

Children are required to wear flat, plain, sensible black shoes. For health and safety reasons, we do not allow pupils to wear shows with platform soles, Heelys or high heels. All footwear should be closed in with no toes visible. Sandals, crocs and flip-flops are not permitted.

We believe that one of the responsibilities of parents is to ensure that their child has the correct uniform and PE kit, and that it is clean, in good repair and that the child's name is written on all items. Children who arrive at school in the incorrect uniform will be provided with the correct items of clothing to wear whilst in school until parents can provide the required uniform. We would like to support our families who are facing difficulties purchasing school uniform so please speak confidentially to Mrs Drew or a senior member of staff to discuss any issues. Parents should be assured that we will do all we can to help.
