In our Geography lessons, we will be finding the answer to the following question:

How could our actions now influence our future world?

This Geography project builds upon the learning completed by the year 6 children in the very first term where we investigated what Immingham is doing to tackle climate change.

Within this project we will look further into what causes global warming and climate change and how human activity can either help or hinder this problem. We will also find out exactly how green-house gasses are involved. A study of different areas of the world, and the effects that climate change is having upon them will be followed by an investigation into what countries around the world are doing to global warming and ensure that we are looking after our planet.
